**MIAMI TOWNSHIP BUFFALO RIDGE  
COMMUNITY GARDEN RULES**

**\*\*These Rules are intended to help the Garden run smoothly. Please cooperate to help make the Garden a Success!\*\***

\*\*\*\*\*

This Garden will be open as soon as the soil may be worked each Spring. The Township Coordinator will notify all gardeners of the date.

Children are welcome in the Garden and encouraged but **MUST BE WITH AN ADULT**. You are responsible for the children you bring into the Garden and seeing to it that they respect other people's gardens.

Plots are available on a random draw each growing season, anyone interested must fill out a form. Anyone not receiving a raised bed at the time of the draw will be added to the wait list for any added or vacated spots during that growing season.

No bed may be gardened without the plot being assigned.

If beds are not planted within the first 30 days of opening, the gardener will be given notice to vacate, and the plot will be reassigned. The coordinator will check with the assigned person to make sure there is not an issue and move forward.

All trash must be put in the proper receptacle be it trash or recycle.

Beds must be maintained and kept free of weeds. Noxious weeds must be thrown out in the trash and NOT put in compost pile. These types of weeds will be posted in the shed.

Other weeds and garden plant waste may and should be placed in the compost.

You may use stakes and trellises, but they must be removable and be removed at the end of the growing season.

**Pesticides and Herbicides MAY NOT BE USED** in the garden unless specifically cleared with written permission from the garden coordinator (even with permission, this will only be allowed at certain times of the year). They are harmful to people and the environment if not administered properly.

**Do not take fruits, flowers, or vegetables from other gardens without permission.** Certain areas or pots may be open to all, but these will be designated and clearly marked. Even then, only take what you need at the time.
